Not A "Tall Tale," But A Very Big Fish Adventure

This is not a "fishy" fish story. Pictured in the photo below is Edward L. Gilroy, proud fisherman who caught this monster rockfish (striped bass) in the Potomac River, just south of the Harry Nice bridge, near the Morgan Point Power Station.

The fish was officially tallied as 38.5 inches long and weighed 23.9 pounds, in November, 1997.

Ed Gilroy (who works at the Coastal Gas Station in White Plains, Maryland) in a small bass boat using a a White, four-inch "Popper Plug" on the surface, had a first strike at about 25 yards out. All he saw was a huge mouth come up and miss the popper. Ed continued to reel in the lure, and about 15 yards out, the big fish surfaced again and, this time, gulped down the lure.

The bass boat had to follow the big fish for a while to get enough slack line to pull it in. It is the biggest fish Ed Gilroy has ever caught. To advertise the fine fishing in Charles County, the Maryland Tourism Office will use this picture.
